Xplorer Squad: Unlock the Past



Photo and Map Game – Who Can Pin It Faster?

Activity Objectives

- Train students to use historical clues to identify real locations.
- Develop map-reading skills (Google Map).
- Promote enjoyment, challenge, and teamwork.

Format and How to Play

- Divide students into groups of 3–5.
- Distribute printed Google Map versions (focusing on the Phra Nakhon district or target area) to each group.
 - Show a set of clues, each clue at a time.
 - Each slide contains four sequential clues.
 - Clues can be revealed one at a time according to timing to make it easier.
- Each group must pin the location on the map as quickly and accurately as possible.
 - Write the name of the location and circle it on the provided map.
 - Collect the answers immediately when the time for each round ends.

For Teachers / Facilitators

Guidelines

- Encourage students to carefully observe the details in each clue, such as roads, buildings, government offices, intersections, or locations connected to a river or canal.
- Prompt students to use the map to confirm their assumptions, for example by tracing positions from major roads, temples, bridges, etc.
- Allow approximately 2-3 minutes per round.
- Prepare the "answer key" and the correct marked location on the map to reveal after each round.

Skills Students Will Gain

- Practising speed in analysis and decision-making.
- Learning to read contemporary maps with a clear purpose. Encouraging constructive competition.


Who Can Pin It Faster?




Game and Rules

- Each location has 4–5 clues.
- Each clue should take no more than 30 seconds to "scan" and identify the place on the prepared map. Smartphones may be used to help locate the position.
- Once a group has found the location, they place a pin; the facilitator will then check whether the answer is correct.


- 1. Situated on the main river of Bangkok.
- 2. The road in front of this location is Maharaj Road.
- 3. Located opposite a famous temple with a towering prang and a large Reclining Buddha image.
- 4. A hub for wholesale and retail trade.
- 5. Located in area A1.



- Situated at the corner of Maharaj Road and Sanam Chai Road, near the old city moat.
- 2. The name of this place refers to maintaining peace and order within the Grand Palace area.
- 3. Located opposite Rajini School.
- 4. Located in area A2.



- Situated on Chak Phet Road, near Phra Pok Klao Bridge.
- 2. Associated with electricity generation and management.
- 3. Close to Wat Ratchaburana (Wat Liap).
- 4. Located in area C2.




Wat Liap

Plants

- 1. Situated on Tri Phet Road.
- 2. To the north stands Sala
 Chalermkrung Royal Theatre as a landmark.
- 3. A centre with hundreds of shops selling a wide variety of goods.
- 4. Located in area C1.




The Old Siam Plaza (Ming Muang Market)

- Located at the junction of Charoen Krung Road and Sanam Chai Road.
- 2. A large green space.
- 3. Directly opposite the Grand Palace.
- 4. One side borders the old city moat.
- 5. Located in area B1.




- 1. Situated at the end of Tri Phet Road.
- 2. South of Suankularb Wittayalai School.
- 3. A transport route between Phra Nakhon and Thonburi.
- 4. Not far from the country's largest flower market.
- 5. Located in area B2.




Memorial Bridge

- 1. Situated on Tri Phet Road.
- 2. Not far from Phra Phuttha Yodfa Bridge crossing the Chao Phraya River to Thonburi.
- 3. Located directly opposite Phahurat Market.
- 4. On the same side as Suankularb Wittayalai School, separated only by a fence.
- 5. Located in area C2.



Poh Change Academy of Arts

- 1. Near the corner where Sanam Chai Road meets Charoen Krung Road.
- 2. Not far from a green space within Rattanakosin Island.
- 3. Close to a government agency responsible for territorial defence.
- 4. Near an experimental (model) hall.
- 5. Located in area B1.



Clock Tower (Replica)

- 1. Situated on a road built during the reign of King Rama IV.
- 2. Not far from a department store linked to Siam's past.
- 3. Located on the corner where
 Charoen Krung Road meets Tri Phet
 Road.
- 4. Located in area C1.
